Did you know that lesbian, gay, and bisexual youth are up to four times more likely to attempt suicide than their heterosexual peers and more than 1/3 of lesbian, gay and bisexual youth report having made a suicide attempt? (D'Augelli AR - Clinical Child Psychiatry and Psychology 2002; Massachusetts Youth Risk Survey 2007)

Did you know that nearly half of young transgender people have seriously thought about taking their lives and one quarter report having made a suicide attempt? (Grossman AH, D'Augelli AR - Suicide and Life Threatening Behavior 2007)
