? Frequently Asked Questions ?

HOW DO I BRING A GUN TO THE DROP OFF-SITE?

- Guns must be placed in a plastic or paper bag or box.

CAN I TRANSPORT THE GUN IN A CAR?

- If transporting the gun by car, the gun must be transported in the trunk of the car.

WHEN DO I GET THE CASH CARD?

- After the gun is screened by officers and determined to be operable, you will be issued a cash card.

CAN I SURRENDER A RIFLE OR SHOTGUN?

- Yes, rifles and shotguns will be accepted. The payout for rifles and shotguns is \$20.
Note: The payout for assault rifles is \$200.

HOW MANY GUNS CAN I SURRENDER?

- You may surrender as many guns as you wish, but you will only receive payment for up to three guns.

IS THERE A PHONE NUMBER I CAN CALL FOR MORE INFORMATION?

- Yes, you can call 311 for information regarding the Bronx Gun Buy Back Program.

CAN ANY MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC SURRENDER A GUN?

- Active or retired law enforcement officers and licensed gun dealers are not eligible to participate in the program.
