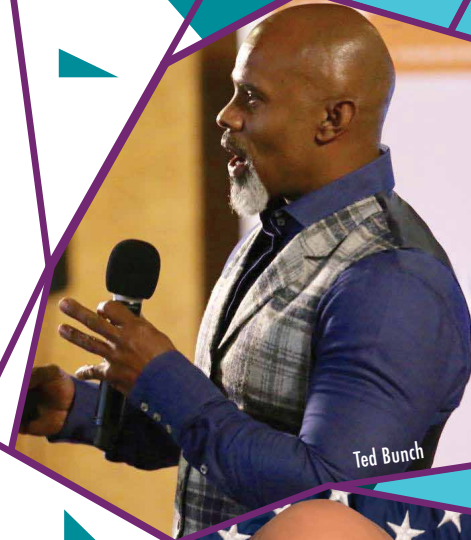

The New York (*Denim Day—April 24, 2019*) **Theme:**
