Day 1

Organizational Strategic Planning & Board Engagement

Gain an understanding of the tools needed when undertaking a project, with an overview of strategic planning and board involvement during all phases of the project will be addressed.

Financial Oversight, Planning & Fundraising

This module will provide a high-level overview of capital budgets and planning; cash flow to cover operating costs; and a business plan to ensure the long-term sustainability of a capital project.

Day 2

The Design and Construction Process

Learn about the pre-construction and construction processes; project cost-control methods; and how to assemble a project team of architecture/design professionals, owner's representatives, contractors, and other consultants.

NYCEDC will discuss New York City's project approval process and how to prepare for it. Discussion topics include prevailing wage requirements, the capital application process and project guidelines
