Introduction

Pursuant to the New York City Charter §82 (17)(a), the Office of the Bronx Borough President (BxBPO) submits this annual report on the applications, selection, and appointment process with detailed information about the demographic makeup community board members for the 2023-24 term.

Bronx Borough President Vanessa L. Gibson has been committed to diversifying and investing in Community Boards since she took office in 2022. In 2022, The Bronx Borough President's Office launched the Community Board Application electronically and in English and Spanish. The Bronx remains the only borough to have a bilingual application. Since 2022, the BxBPO has received over two thousand applications from city residents interested in serving on their local Community Board, many of them being first time applicants. Each year the BxBPO updates the Community Board Application to better fit the process and better capture demographic information of all applicants.

In 2024, five hundred and eighty four individuals applied to serve on a Bronx Community Board. This is the largest applicant pool during Borough President Gibson's tenure as Borough President.

Bronx Borough President Gibson remains committed to appointing a diverse and representative board in each community district. This goes beyond mere demographic diversity but also includes housing diversity (renters, public housing residents, homeowners, etc.), age, gender, professional background, sexual orientation, etc. It is critical that each of the twelve Bronx Community Boards accurately reflect the concerns and sentiments of the entire district that they represent, including those historically disengaged from civic engagement. This includes increasing youth participation and using a data-driven approach to ensure community board membership accurately reflects the demographics of the districts they represent.

Borough President Gibson strives to have Community Boards accurately mirror the concerns and views of the entire district they represent, including those who have historically been less involved in civically

Application & Outreach

In 2024, Bronx Borough President Vanessa L. Gibson launched the digital and bilingual Community Board application on January 22, 2024, with a strong outreach campaign throughout the Borough. To increase the overall number of applicants, the application deadline was extended through March 8th.

The office works diligently to make the application available and accessible. Former applicants and those interested in serving received the link via direct correspondence. The application was posted digitally on the Borough President's website and across her social media platforms. The Community Board Unit in partnership with the Community Affairs team distributed flyers to all Community Boards, nonprofit organizations, health centers, hospitals, schools, BIDs and other key Bronx institutions. The application was also distributed in the BxBPO's newsletter and the BxBPO's email distribution list, which includes but is not limited to: Borough residents, NYCHA leaders, veteran groups, immigrant organizations, religious organizations, etc. Additionally, the Borough President makes a public announcement on News 12's monthly "Ask the Borough President" segment and utilizes other local newspapers and press outlets to spread the word. Information on applying to Community boards was also publicized at Community Board Meetings as well as Borough Board/ Borough Service Cabinet Meetings. Word of mouth continues to be an important and effective measure of outreach. The BxBPO works with the NYC Office of Technology & Innovation on getting the flyer posted on Link NYC Kiosks around the borough.

In 2024, the Borough President continued to prioritize outreach at local high schools and colleges. The BxBPO attended several high schools, made presentations, and engaged with interested students. Staff visited NYPL locations throughout the borough to hand out flyers and visit the Bronx VA Hospital with application information. Staff directly engaged with the BxBPO's Youth Council, which served as credible messengers to their schools and networks. Staff worked with the Bronx Youth Council on mock meetings, the creation of their bylaws, and the formation of their executive committees.

The Appointment Process

Once an individual applies, a member of the BxBPO team will reach out for an interview, whether the individual is a new applicant or seeking reappointment.

City Council Members were provided with links to the application database for their respective boards. The BxBPO team met with Council Members and/or staff to review the appointment process. The BxBPO team consults with Board Chairs & District Managers regarding those reapplying to the boards and individuals seeking new appointments. During this process, the team reviews full board and committee attendance records.

Once Council Members provided their appointment recommendations, the Borough President reviewed current demographic data for each board's membership. The BxBP also reviews a map showing where current residents live and where new applicants live to ensure each corner of the board is represented.

The Borough President made appointments based on the qualifications, experience, and profession of the applicants while taking into account current demographics to ensure diversity on the board. These self-identifiable demographics include race, age, gender, sexual orientation, veteran status, disability, union membership, housing tenure, neighborhood residence, and professional background.

The Community Boards should represent the full richness of the community, so it is critical to ensure that all residents see themselves represented on the boards. For members seeking reappointment, the Borough President strongly considered attendance and performance over the past term.

The Borough President appointed one hundred and seventy-four new Community Board Members. This is due to two factors, for instance, the number of applications varied widely from board to board. It is important that the number of vacancies is constantly changing because membership is dynamic due to resignations and removals.

The BxBPO cannot legally require members or applicants to fill out demographic information.

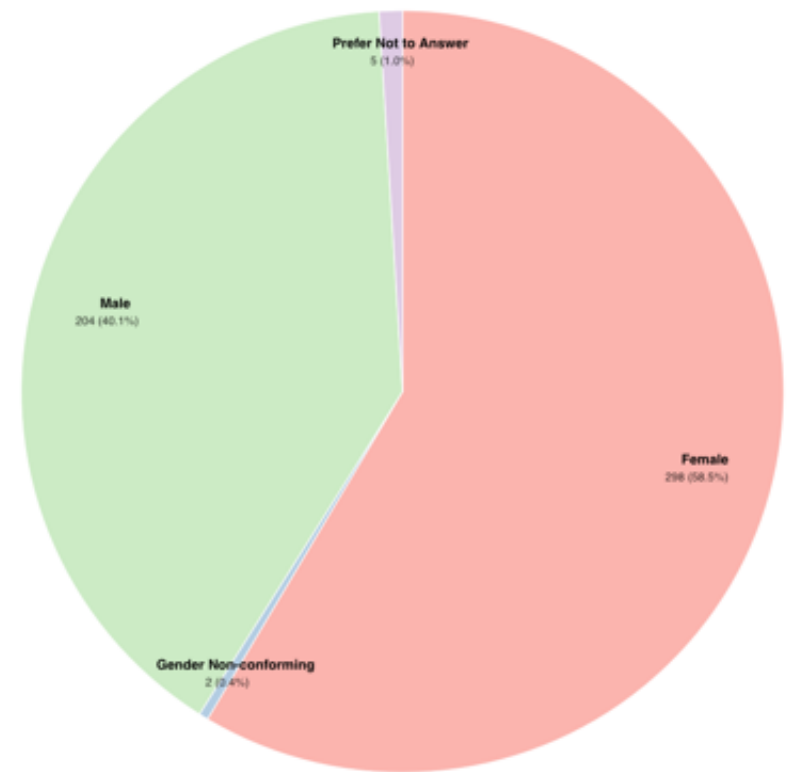

Borough Wide Demographics

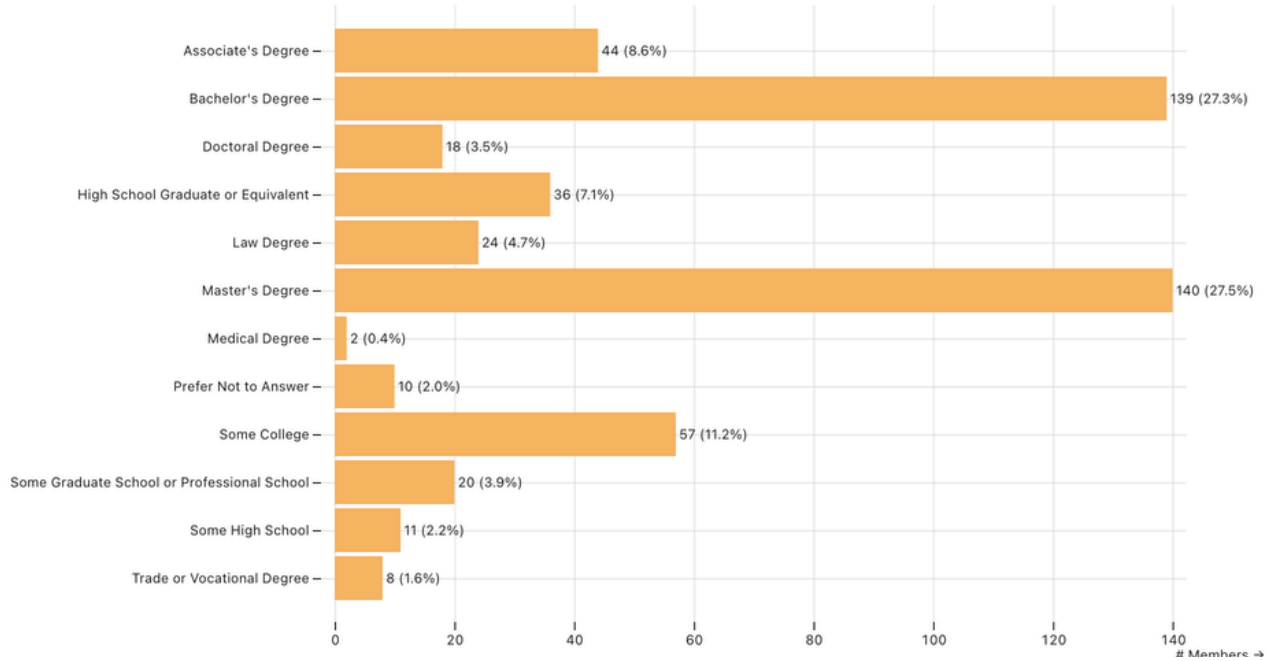
